Moving tips

Below are some things you may need to do when you're moving home. Please remember this might not be everything because all moves are different.

People to notify

- Your gas, electricity, water, insurance, phone, internet and any other suppliers.
- Your local council (and the council in your new area if you're moving away).
- Your doctor, dentist and optician, if you're moving out of the area.
- TV Licensing, to let them know you're moving: www.tvlicensing.co.uk.
- The DVLA, to change the address on your driving licence: www.dft.gov.uk/dvla.
- Your bank, to make any changes to direct debits or standing orders.
- The post office, to have your mail forwarded - there may be a small charge for this service.

Things to arrange and do

- Organise your removal company and confirm the moving date and time.
- Make sure you arrange for any gas appliances to be disconnected and reconnected by a Gas Safe registered engineer.
- Make sure you take any animals with you on the day you leave.
- Turn off your gas and electricity and write down your meter readings on the day you leave.
- Check all windows and doors are shut and locked.
- Label all your keys and return them to us when you leave, making sure you include front and back door keys (if applicable) and garage keys (if you have one).
- Shed and window keys should be left in the property.
- Please leave your pre-pay gas card and pre-pay electric key in the property (if applicable).
